REQUEST FOR REVIEW AND WAIVER

INTRODUCTION

Section 54.719(c) of the Commission’s rules provides that any person aggrieved by an action taken by a division of the Universal Service Administrative Company may seek review from the Commission.¹ Baltimore City Public School System (BCPSS) hereby appeals the current action taken by USAC in the following case.

BACKGROUND

On April 3, 2007, BCPSS received funding commitment decisions for the following Funding Year 2006 Internal Connections FRNs listed below.

At this time, BCPSS is not appealing FRN 1486981. Even though the requested discount rate was reduced by the SLD, BCPSS later asked the SLD to cancel this FRN. Both of the FRNs associated with Form 471 #534030 are being appealed. In both cases, the District filed the FRNs requesting an 88% shared discount rate. During PIA, the SLD reduced the requested discount rate to 81% and then denied the requests for falling below the Priority Two discount rate threshold.²

DISCUSSION

BCPSS has attached as Exhibit B, a copy of their Form 471 Block 4 information reported on Application # 534030 which was filed on February 16, 2006. When the District filed the original Form 471 application, there were selected sites which used an alternative discount mechanism to determine the requested discount rate for those select school sites. During PIA the use of the alternative discount mechanism was questioned by the PIA reviewer. The PIA reviewer also questioned BCPSS regarding discount rate validation for numerous other sites contained on the Form 471.

BCPSS knows that during PIA some kind of alteration of their discount information took place. When BCPSS received their copy of the Funding Commitment Decision Letter, the explanation given by the SLD was as follows, “The shared discount was reduced. Given demand, the funding cap will not provide for Internal Connections/Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections at your approved discount level to be funded.”

Currently, this is the only explanation BCPSS has received regarding the reduction in the shared discount rate. When BCPSS received their FCDL, no further information regarding any changes made to the Block 4 data and the shared discount rate were included. Without this information, BCPSS is unable to effectively appeal or verify the reduction to their shared discount rate. BCPSS is also unable to re-create how the PIA reviewer reached an 81% shared discount rate.

At this time, BCPSS would request the FCC to remand the case back to the SLD with orders to provide the District with an explanation of the reduction, or alternatively, to determine that the NSLP data as provided to the State of Maryland supports a shared discount rate of 86 % and order the SLD to fund the requests at this shared discount level.

NSLP Data Supports a Shared Discount Rate of 86 %

Even though the use of alternative discount methods is allowed and USAC provides guidance for their use on the USAC website, the District recognizes the SLD is currently adjusting shared discount rate levels to match data that can be verified by a third party. One such third party that the SLD uses to verify NSLP data is the NSLP data located on the relevant State Department of Education website. A copy of BCPSS NSLP report as submitted to the Maryland Department of Education is attached as Exhibit C.³ As this report shows, BCPSS has “third party” NSLP data that supports a shared discount rate of 86 %. A copy of the shared discount rate calculations for App. 534030 is attached as Exhibit D.

The FCC Form 471 Instructions require an applicant to “(p)rovide the number of students eligible for NSLP as of the October 1st prior to the filing of this form, or use the most current figure available.”⁴ In keeping with these instructions, BCPSS has used the NSLP data from October 31, 2005. Additionally, it is the understanding of BCPSS that the October 31, 2005 data would have been the data posted on the State of Maryland website and available for use by the SLD PIA reviewer.

³ The Report provided to the State includes the enrollment and NSLP data for all BCPSS sites. On Application 534030, only 101 sites were originally listed. BCPSS used the data from these 101 sites to calculate the shared discount rate for Application 534030 using the NSLP data as provided to the State. To reach the number of students eligible for the Free and Reduced Price Lunch Program, BCPSS added the number of students who qualified for free lunch, the number of students who qualified for reduced price lunch, and the number of students who were directly certified for the NSLP.

At this time, BCPSS has not been provided an explanation as to why the SLD reduced the requested shared discount rate to 81% percent instead of 86% as supported by third party data


The SLD changing Block 4 data without explanation will cause some fundamental problems for applicants.

The SLD has not provided BCPSS any kind of explanation of how the SLD PIA reviewer adjusted the Block 4 data. At the very least, the SLD should provide all applicants an explanation of any Block 4 changes made during PIA. This information is necessary so applicants can appropriately respond to the PIA review and have the ability to prepare an appeal if necessary. BCPSS is unable at this time to determine which school site(s) were reduced by the PIA reviewer. Without this information, BCPSS is unable to effectively appeal or address the reductions made to the individual school sites and the requested shared discount rate.

SUMMARY

BCPSS requests that the discount rate percentage reductions be reversed and the above referenced FRNs be funded at the discount rate substantiated by the third party data provided by BCPSS. In the alternative, BCPSS would request the FCC to remand the case back to the SLD with orders the SLD provide BCPSS with the Block 4 data for App. 534030 as changed by the SLD reviewer.

A GUIDE TO THE FUNDING COMMITMENT REPORT

A report for each funding request in your application is attached to this letter. We are providing the following definitions for the items in that report.

FORM 471 APPLICATION NUMBER: The unique identifier assigned to a Form 471 application by USAC.

FUNDING REQUEST NUMBER (FRN): A Funding Request Number is assigned by USAC to each Block 5 of your Form 471. This number is used to report to applicants and service providers the status of individual funding requests submitted.

FUNDING STATUS: Each FRN will have one of the following statuses:

1. "Funded" - the FRN is approved for support. The funding level will generally be the level requested unless USAC determined during the application review process that some adjustment is appropriate.
2. "Not Funded" - the FRN is one for which no funds were committed. The reason for the decision will be briefly explained in the "Funding Commitment Decision Explanation." An FRN may be "Not Funded" because the request does not comply with program rules, or because the total amount of funding available for the Funding Year was insufficient to fund all requests.
3. NUMBER OF MONTHS RECURRING SERVICE PROVIDED IN FUNDING YEAR: The number of months of service that has been approved for the funding year, for recurring services.

ANNUAL PRE-DISCOUNT AMOUNT FOR ELIGIBLE RECURRING CHARGES: Eligible monthly pre-discount amount approved for recurring charges multiplied by number of months of recurring service approved for the funding year.

ANNUAL PRE-DISCOUNT AMOUNT FOR ELIGIBLE NON-RECURRING CHARGES: Annual eligible non-recurring charges approved for the funding year.
