Dear Ms. Dortch:

Comptel L.P. (d/b/a Excel Communications) (“Excel”), by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Commission, pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, of a meeting held on May 1, 2007 with Albert Lewis, Victoria Goldberg, Lynne Engledow, Deena Shelter, Pamela Arluk and Jay Atkinson of the Wireline Bureau. Excel was represented by James Cashiola, its Chief Executive Office, John Jenkins, its Chief Administrative Officer, and the undersigned.

During this meeting, Excel noted that the FCC’s regulations require prepaid calling card services to utilize Feature Group D or Feature Group A for obtaining origination when providing interstate or international services. Based on Excel’s review of telephone numbers listed on numerous prepaid calling cards, it is abundantly clear that many prepaid calling card services were using local access to originate interstate or international telephone calls and thus not paying access charges. This situation puts interexchange carriers, such as Excel, who offer 8xx service utilizing Feature Group D to obtain local access, at an intolerable competitive disadvantage vis-à-vis prepaid calling card services using local access.
