Re: Certification Of High Cost Support Pursuant To 47 C.F.R. §§ 54.313-314, CC Docket No. 96-45

Dear Ms. Dortch / Ms. Majcher:

In an order dated March 30, 2007 ("Order"), the Iowa Utilities Board ("Board") granted a motion by United States Cellular Corporation ("U.S. Cellular") (SAC 359016), a competitive eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") to amend its ETC service area to include areas acquired from Long Lines Wireless, LLC ("Long Line") (SAC 359101), another competitive ETC. The Board has previously submitted a high-cost certification under §§ 54.313 and 54.314 of the FCC rules covering calendar year 2007 that includes both Long Lines and U.S. Cellular. Accordingly, the Board believes no further certifications are needed to ensure uninterrupted support in the areas acquired from Long Lines through the end of 2007. Nonetheless, at the request of U.S. Cellular, we submit this supplemental certification out of an abundance of caution to make clear that U.S. Cellular is certified in the areas it acquired from Long Lines. Therefore, the Board hereby certifies that all high-cost support provided to U.S. Cellular will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended. This certification is intended to cover the time period from March 30, 2007, through December 31, 2007, and it applies to U.S. Cellular's ETC service area as amended in the IUB's Order.
