Verizon conducted a call today with Ms. Michelle Carey and Ms. Heather Dixon of the Chairman's office. Mr. David Young, Mr. Will Johnson and I represented Verizon. We restated our position as set forth in our Forbearance proceeding and explained that the Verizon FiOS TV offering is an all-digital network. We also told Ms. Carey that Verizon considers the recently released Notice of Proposed Rulemaking addressing the subject of exclusive contracts between incumbent cable providers and multiple dwelling units to be of major importance since exclusive access agreements are a barrier for the new video entrant.
