**Re: Notice of Oral Ex Parte Presentation
WT Docket No. 01-108 and RM-11355**

Dear Ms. Dortch,

On May 14, on behalf of AT&T, Inc., Robert W. Quinn, Senior Vice President, Federal Regulatory and Brian Fontes, Vice President Federal Relations met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and her Legal Advisor, Aaron Goldberger. The focus of the discussion was the analog sunset and responding to the claims made by Alarm Industry Communications Committee (AICC) and ADT Security Services (ADT).

Specifically, we reviewed the facts that all parties, including the alarm industry, have been on notice for years that wireless carriers will sunset their analog networks on or shortly after February 18, 2008, consistent with Commission's decision in this docket. The cost to AT&T of maintaining an analog network post February 18, 2008 is substantial, estimated to be \$8 million per month. This cost is especially burdensome since we anticipate having few or no analog customers by the sunset date in February, 2008. Also, maintaining an analog network is not an efficient use of spectrum. Filings by some in the alarm industry show that they are deploying digital technology today primarily for new customers, yet some are failing to make the investment necessary to replace their current analog customer equipment. Rather than making the investment in replacing their existing customers' analog equipment, some in the alarm industry would prefer to impose a cost both in dollars and spectrum efficiency on the wireless industry.
