Implementation of Section 255 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 to
interconnected VoIP

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Friday, May 18, 2007, Rebecca Schwartz, representing the Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA), met with Scott Bergmann, Legal Advisor to FCC Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein. The purpose of the meeting was for TIA to disseminate its position on the application of Section 255 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 to Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP). TIA urged the Commission to refrain from applying any unnecessary regulations to an emerging technology such as VoIP. Further, TIA stated that it is currently working with the disability community to voluntarily develop accessibility features and overly-burdensome regulation would impede this progress.
