REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Media Access Project respectfully asks that the Commission extend the comment and reply comment dates in this matter by 30 days.

By *Public Notice* released on May 4, 2007, the Policy Division of the Media Bureau invited further comments to refresh the record in the above-captioned matter. (DA 07-2005, released May 7, 2007). The *Public Notice* was published in the *Federal Register* on May 17, 2007. Accordingly, comments are currently due on or before June 18, 2007, and reply comments are due on or before July 3, 2007. Under the requested revision, comments would be due on or before July 18, 2007, and replies would be due on or before August 2, 2007.

The basis for this request is that the current filing dates overlap with comment deadlines in several major proceedings as to which the Commission has little or no discretion with respect to affording additional time, most particularly the 700 MHz auction matter under review in Docket 06-150 and related proceedings. Many of the participants in those proceedings are likely commenters in Docket 93-8. If the Commission is to develop a full record in Docket 93-8, it should afford additional time to undertake the research necessary to achieve that goal.

WHEREFORE, Media Access Project asks that the Commission extend the comment and reply comment deadlines in this matter by 30 days, and grant all such other relief as may be just and proper.
