Pursuant to the *Wireline Broadband Order*¹, Mulberry Cooperative Telephone Company, Inc. (Mulberry Telephone), an issuing carrier in NECA Tariff F.C.C. NO. 5, files the enclosed notice of their intent to discontinue its Digital Subscriber Line Service under NECA Tariff F.C.C. NO. 5. Effective June 30, 2007, Mulberry Telephone will provide Digital Subscriber Line Service on a de-tariffed common carrier basis and will discontinue the tariffed offerings for this service through the NECA Tariff F.C.C. NO. 5.

Mulberry Telephone has notified their current affected customers per the attached memo dated May 30, 2007. The geographic areas Mulberry Telephone serves the town of Mulberry, Indiana and its nearby areas outside of Mulberry within its own telephone exchange. There will be no significant change to our customers with Mulberry's choice to detariff this product as neither the current rates nor provisioning of these services will be affected by this decision. Effective June 30, 2007, the terms and conditions under which DSL will be offered by Mulberry Telephone will be posted for public inspection on our website at www.mintel.net and a physical copy of the offerings will also be located at our office located at 123 South Glick Street in Mulberry, Indiana 46058.



RE: Notice of De-tariffing of Common Carrier Broadband Internet
Access Transmission Service Effective June 30, 2007

This is an informational notice, *no action necessary on your part*, required by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that Mulberry Cooperative Telephone (Mulberry Telephone) will discontinue providing Digital Subscriber Line Access Service on a tariffed basis. Effective June 30, 2007, Mulberry Telephone will no longer participate in NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 for Digital Subscriber Line Access Service (found in Section 8 of the NECA Tariff No. 5). However, the services will be offered on a de-tariffed Title II Common Carrier basis.

Mulberry Telephone serves the town of Mulberry, Indiana and its nearby areas outside of Mulberry within the Mulberry telephone exchange. The services and rates for your current Digital Subscriber Line Access Service are not changing. However, effective June 30, 2007, they will be available for public inspection on our website at www.mintel.net and at our office located at 123 South Glick Street in Mulberry, Indiana 46058.
