**SUPPLEMENT TO  
PETITION FOR TEMPORARY WAIVER OR TEMPORARY STAY**

South Slope Cooperative Telephone Co., Inc. d/b/a South Slope Wireless ("South Slope"), by its attorney and in response to the May 24, 2007 e-mail request for information from the Commission's staff, hereby supplements its "Petition for Temporary Waiver or Temporary Stay" ("Petition"), filed September 18, 2006, as follows:

1. **Question No. 1: Does South Slope presently market (and make available for in-store testing by consumers) at least two digital wireless handset models per air interface that meet at least a U3T (or T3) rating for inductive coupling under ANSI Standard C63.19?**
2. **Answer to Question No. 1: Yes.**
3. **Question No. 2: On what date did South Slope first comply with the requirement (*i.e.*, on what date did it first offer two compliant handset models)?**

4. Answer to Question No. 2: March 22, 2007.

5. Question No. 3: For each air interface for which South Slope requests a waiver (*i.e.*, GSM), which two handsets were offered on the initial compliance date (*i.e.*, which ones for GSM)? For each handset please provide: a) the manufacturer's name; b) the model number; and c) the FCC ID Number for these two T-Coil certified handsets.

6. Answer to Question No. 3:

7. Question No. 4: If South Slope does not comply, please provide an estimate of when South Slope expects to be in compliance.


8. Answer to Question No. 4: Not applicable. South Slope is in compliance.


**DECLARATION UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY**


I, J. R. Brumley, hereby state the following:
