SUPPLEMENT TO  
PETITION FOR TEMPORARY WAIVER OR TEMPORARY STAY

IT&E Overseas, Inc. ("IT&E"), by its attorney and in response to the May 24, 2007 e-mail request for information from the Commission's staff, hereby supplements its "Petition for Temporary Waiver or Temporary Stay" ("Petition"), filed September 13, 2006, as follows:

1. **Question No. 1: Does IT&E presently market (and make available for in-store testing by consumers) at least two digital wireless handset models per air interface that meet at least a U3T (or T3) rating for inductive coupling under ANSI Standard C63.19?**

2. **Answer to Question No. 1:** The answer is "Yes" for the CDMA air interface facilities, and "No" for the GSM air interface facilities.

3. **Question No. 2: On what date did IT&E first comply with the requirement (i.e., on what date did it first offer two compliant handset models)?**

4. **Answer to Question No. 2:** December 5, 2006 for CDMA.

5. **Question No. 3:** For each air interface for which IT&E requests a waiver (*i.e.*, CDMA and GSM), which two handsets were offered on the initial compliance date (*i.e.*, which ones for CDMA and which ones for GSM)? For each handset please provide: a) the manufacturer's name; b) the model number; and c) the FCC ID Number for these two T-Coil certified handsets.

6. **Answer to Question No. 3:** For CDMA, the answer is as follows

<u>Manufacturer</u>	<u>Model</u>	<u>FCC ID No.</u>
Motorola	RAZR V3m	IHDT56FT1
Motorola	KRZR K1m	IHDT56GH1

For GSM, there are presently no compliant handsets available to IT&E.

7. **Question No. 4:** If IT&E does not comply, please provide an estimate of when IT&E expects to be in compliance.


8. **Answer to Question No. 4:** Not applicable with respect to CDMA because IT&E is in compliance. With respect to GSM, IT&E expects to be in compliance sometime between August 1, 2007 and September 1, 2007.

**WHEREFORE**, IT&E renews its request that the Petition be granted.


