Supplement to Petition for Waiver**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Centennial Communications Corp. (“Centennial”), and at the request of FCC staff, this letter is submitted to supplement Centennial’s Petition For Waiver of Section 20.19(d)(2) of the Commission’s Rules (“Waiver Petition”), which was filed with the Commission on September 18, 2006. Centennial’s original Waiver Petition sought a nine month extension, until June 18, 2007, of the requirement that CMRS providers offer by September 18, 2006, at least two handset models with a U3T rating that are compatible with hearing aids that use inductive coupling.

As explained in the Waiver Petition, Centennial provides CMRS service in the continental United States and in the Caribbean. In its domestic markets, Centennial provides digital service utilizing a GSM air interface and Motorola, Nokia, Sony Ericsson, LG and Samsung equipment. In the Caribbean market, Centennial utilizes a CDMA air interface and Motorola and Nokia handsets. Consequently, Centennial is providing responses to the questions raised by FCC staff for both its domestic and Caribbean operations.

I. Domestic Operations:

Following are Centennial's responses to the four questions raised by the staff:

- 1) Current Compliance: As Centennial explained in its Waiver Petition, as of September 18, 2006, Centennial offered one handset with a U3T rating (the LG2000). Centennial will offer two additional handsets with a T3 rating by later this month, specifically, by June 18, 2007.
- 2) Date of Compliance: June 18, 2007
- 3) T3 Handset Information:
 - A) LG2000 – FCC ID # BEJC2000 – Offered September 18, 2006
 - B) Nokia 6085 - LJPRM-198H – To be offered by June 18, 2007
 - C) Nokia 6126H - PPIRM-126H – To be offered by June 18, 2007
- 4) Estimated Date of Compliance: June 18, 2007 for the two new T3 handsets.

II. Caribbean Operations:

Following are Centennial's responses to the four questions raised by the staff:

- 1) Current Compliance: In Puerto Rico, Centennial currently offers two handsets with at least a T3 rating. Its first T3-rated handset was introduced on November 2, 2006.
- 2) Date of Compliance: January 3, 2007
- 3) T3 Handset Information:
 - A) Motorola KRZR (K1) – FCC ID # IHDT56GH1 - Offered November 2, 2006
 - B) Motorola RAZR V3m – FCC ID # IHDT56FT1 – Offered January 3, 2007
- 4) Estimated Date of Compliance: Centennial's Caribbean operations were fully compliant with Section 20.19(d)(2) of the rules by January 3, 2007.

For the reasons stated in the original Waiver Petition, Centennial respectfully requests that the Commission grant its request for a nine-month waiver of the inductive coupling handset deadline. Centennial will be fully compliant in all of its markets by its proposed June 18 alternative deadline.
