On June 1, 2007, Mike Fingerhut of Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”); Jeff Rosen of Snap Telecommunications, Inc. (“Snap”) and Frank Buono of Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP, counsel for Snap; Mike Maddix of Sorenson Communications, Inc. (“Sorenson”); and Ruth Milkman and Richard Metzger of Lawler, Metzger, Milkman & Keeney, LLC, counsel for Sorenson, met separately with Nick Alexander, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Tate and John Hunter, Legal Advisor to Commissioner McDowell. During the meetings, Sprint Nextel, Snap and Sorenson discussed the interstate telecommunications relay services (“TRS”) fund payment formulas that were submitted to the FCC by the National Exchange Carrier Association (“NECA”) on May 1, 2007,<sup>1</sup> as well as the price cap-based methodology proposed by several providers, including Sprint Nextel, Snap and Sorenson. The discussion was consistent with the parties’ previous written submissions filed in the above-referenced docket.
