
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC's ("Frontline's") counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On June 5, 2007, Jonathan Blake and Gerard Waldron met with Sam Feder, the Commission's General Counsel, as well as Christopher Killion, Joel Kaufman and David Horowitz from the Office of the General Counsel. In the meeting, the parties discussed Frontline's Public Safety Deployment Plan and the network sharing agreement which would be negotiated between the E Block licensee and public safety. Further, the parties spoke about the Commission's small business rules and emphasized that qualified small businesses should be eligible for bidding credits in the "E" block auction under those rules. Finally, the parties discussed potential secondary commercial use of the public safety spectrum and this proposal's clear compliance with Section 337.
