MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Mobile Satellite Ventures Subsidiary LLC (“MSV”), by its attorneys, hereby submits this motion seeking an extension of the deadline for filing reply comments in the above-captioned proceeding.^{1/} Specifically, MSV requests that the date for filing reply comments be extended from June 11 until July 2, 2007. MSV hopes to use the additional time to have discussions with the parties to attempt to find a compromise. Thus, good cause exists to grant this motion.

The short 21-day delay should not prejudice any of the parties to this proceeding, but may provide the Commission with a plan that could expedite a final decision in this docket. We have been authorized to state that Comsearch, Conterra Ultra Broadband LLC, FiberTower Corporation, the Fixed Wireless Communications Coalition, Intelsat Ltd. And Union Telephone Company do not object to this extension request.
