Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 7, 2007 at the end of a meeting on another subject, Andrew Jay Schwartzman of Media Access Project briefly discussed the above-captioned matter with Commissioner Adelstein. Others present at the time were Angela Campbell, Marvin Ammori, and Corie Wright of the Institute for Public Representation (IPR) and Rudy Brioché, Katie Yocum, Margaux Berwitt, and Christopher Noam of Commissioner Adelstein's staff.

In the conversation, Mr. Schwartzman stressed the significance of adopting a band plan and auction rules which provide incentives for new entrants to enter the 700 MHz auction as bidders. He acknowledged that relatively few new entrants have publicly stated an intention to participate in the forthcoming 700 MHz auction, but argued that it is unlikely that venture capitalists and other investors will consider participating in the auction until it is clear that the auction conditions will enable them to have a reasonable opportunity to prevail.
