On June 7, 2007, Mike Fingerhut of Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”); Jeff Rosen of Snap Telecommunications, Inc. (“Snap”) and Frank Buono of Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP, counsel for Snap; Mike Maddix of Sorenson Communications, Inc. (“Sorenson”); and Ruth Milkman and Richard Metzger of Lawler, Metzger, Milkman & Keeney, LLC, counsel for Sorenson, met with Ian Dillner, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin. During the meeting, the parties discussed appropriate performance metrics for video relay service (“VRS”), the disallowances that NECA had recommended in the 2007-08 rate proceeding, the importance of marketing and outreach to the success of VRS and the benefits of a three-year price cap-based approach for setting VRS rates. The discussion was consistent with the parties’ previous written submissions filed in the above-referenced docket.
