Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Chase Carey, CEO of The DIRECTV Group, Inc. ("DIRECTV"), Bruce Churchill, DIRECTV's Executive Vice President and President, New Ventures, Bill Little, DIRECTV's Senior Vice President, Treasurer & Business Development, and I met with Commissioner Adelstein and his Senior Legal Advisor, Barry Ohlson. Consistent with DIRECTV's prior submissions, we discussed the 4G Coalition's proposal for the auction of 700 MHz spectrum. We also discussed the importance of setting rules that would encourage nationwide competition to incumbent broadband providers, including the availability of at least some form of nationwide license, sufficient bandwidth for such licenses, and reasonable build-out requirements.
