Virgin Mobile USA, LLC ("Virgin Mobile") files this letter to clarify certain information filed in the above-referenced dockets by the Wireless Founders Coalition for Innovation ("Wireless Founders Coalition") on June 7, 2007. According to its filing, the Wireless Founders Coalition purports to represent a number of "seasoned wireless industry entrepreneurs who have founded wireless companies that now generate billions of dollars in revenue and have created thousands of jobs."

Among the signatories to the Wireless Founders Coalition filing are two individuals, Amol Sarva and John Tantum, who state that they are co-founders of Virgin Mobile. While these individuals were early stage employees, both departed prior to Virgin Mobile's commencement of national prepaid wireless services in July 2002. At the time of their departure, Virgin Mobile had no wireless operations, revenues or customers.

Accordingly, Virgin Mobile would like to clarify that the views expressed by both of these individuals in the Wireless Founders Coalition filing specifically and with respect to wireless industry issues in general do not represent the views of Virgin Mobile, its existing management, or ownership.
