

Formerly I was doing business as *Sierra Grande Broadcasting*. I am the grantee of the vacant Salina, Utah 233C FM allotment. I was not furnished with a copy of the counterproposal that would move the Salina, Utah 233C FM allotment to Salina, Utah 239C. I mailed in a change of address during June 2004. I did not see my change of address listed for either of my two granted FM allotments, nor my remaining two FM proposals.

From an engineering standpoint I have no problem with the proposed change from Salina, Utah 233C to Salina, Utah 239C. The Delta, Utah 240C1 FM allotment is being moved out of the area. This counterproposal will allow me to use the White Pine Peak radio site, that was formerly used by the Delta, Utah 239C FM allotment. When I talked to the people at Fishlake National Forest they preferred that I use White Pine Peak instead of the two peaks that I was interested in using.

With this counterproposal, Delta, Utah may be losing its city of license FM service, but the area will still be served by the Salina, Utah 239C FM proposal, if granted. The service area of KNAK is reduced at night, but a FM station has the same service area day and night. The area surrounding Delta, Utah will still be served by the Salina, Utah 239C FM allotment.

I am just committing on the change of Salina, Utah 233C to Salina, Utah 239C. I have not
