I support the XM / Sirius merger. I ask that you do so, as well. I have subscribed to each service and would appreciate the opportunity to listen to both services on a single subscription.

An increase in bandwidth means that larger numbers of voices of greater diversity can be broadcast. Mainstream AM/FM radio is no different in any city that I travel to. Satellite services allow me to hear from voices supportive of multiple cultures and languages - no matter where I am. I appreciate the freedom of speech exists on this consumer driven, paid service.

A merger approval also allows greater opportunities for my children to listen to appropriate content - while giving me, the parent, the opportunity to make choices for them thanks to receiver technology.
