Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 13, 2007, Andrew Rein and the undersigned on behalf of Access Spectrum, LLC, spoke by telephone to Cathleen Massey, Peter Corea and Richard Arsenault of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. On that call, Access Spectrum discussed the need for a process for implementing the conversion of public safety narrowband systems as well as the necessary changes to the Computer Assisted Pre-Coordination Resource and Database System ("CAPRAD") that would be necessitated by the consolidation of the narrowband spectrum in the upper 700 MHz. Access Spectrum stated that the process should include vendors, public safety associations, and individual public safety agencies, as well as Access Spectrum and Pegasus, the parties that have agreed to fund the retuning, as described in their May 23, 2007 comments.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, this letter is being submitted for inclusion in the public record in the above-referenced proceedings.
