Dear FCC:

I am in COMPLETE SUPPORT of the XM-Sirius merger. The NAB would not be contesting this merger if they weren't afraid of the COMPETITION introduced from a merged satellite radio company. In just October of last year, NAB's CEO David Rehr said in a speech to the National Press Club, "Who are the newer competitors?...On the radio side, we have satellite radio, Internet radio, iPODs, other MP3 players, cell phones and others." It couldn't be more clear than this. The market now consists of all these mediums and the XM-Sirius merger should NOT be considered a monopoly.
