On June 15, 2007, Caressa Bennet of Bennet & Bennet, PLLC, representing the Rural Telecommunications Group, Inc. ("RTG"), and Jill Canfield, Senior Regulatory Counsel for the National Telecommunications Cooperative Association ("NTCA") met with Aaron Goldberger and Christopher Koves from Commissioner Tate's office to discuss the above-referenced proceeding.

During the meeting, the group discussed the size of the geographic areas to be licensed in the upcoming 700 MHz auction, the Commission's proposed build-out requirements for licensees and RTG's and NTCA's opposition to proposed "blind bidding" and combinatorial bidding rules.
