**Re: Consolidated Application for Authority to Transfer Control  
MB Docket No. 07-18**

Dear Mr. Ottele:

On January 30, 2007, the Commission received a consolidated application from News Corporation ("News Corp."), The DIRECTV Group, Inc. and Liberty Media Corporation ("Liberty Media") seeking consent to transfer control of various Commission licenses and authorizations held by The DIRECTV Group, Inc. and its subsidiaries (collectively "DIRECTV") from News Corp. to Liberty Media.<sup>1</sup> In order for the Commission to review the consolidated application and make the necessary public interest findings under section 310(d) of the Communications Act,<sup>2</sup> we require information from Liberty Global.

Accordingly, pursuant to sections 4(i), 4(j) and 403 of the Act,<sup>3</sup> we request that you provide written responses and supporting documentation for the questions set forth in the attached Information and Document Request. We understand that you received a copy of the Information and Document Request on June 20, 2007 from counsel for Liberty Media Corporation. We would appreciate receiving your responses no later than **Monday, July 9, 2007**. Information and documents called for by the requests, as well as narrative responses, should be grouped based on the request to which they are responsive. All such material shall be so marked and shall be separated from the responses to other requests.

Your responses should be filed with Marlene H. Dortch, Secretary, FCC, under reference number MB Docket No. 07-18. For any responses that contain confidential or proprietary information, please follow the filing instructions set forth in the Protective Order.<sup>4</sup> For all hand deliveries pertaining to the Protective Order, please call William Beckwith (202-418-0134) to schedule receipt of hand delivery or, in his absence, Brenda Lewis (202-418-1447). For any responses that are submitted on paper that do not contain confidential or proprietary information,
