Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 22, 2007, Susanne Guyer, Kathleen Grillo, and Karen Zacharia of Verizon and Scott Angstreich of Kellogg, Huber, Hansen, Todd, Evans & Figel, P.L.L.C., met with Tom Navin, Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau, Marcus Maher, Associate Deputy Bureau Chief, and Randy Clarke, Legal Counsel to the Bureau Chief, to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. Verizon stated that the Commission should move forward and ensure that all VoIP services are considered interstate services — regardless of the technology or provider — and are subject to the same rules and regulations. In particular, the Commission should ensure that all VoIP providers, regardless of platform, compete on a level playing field, and that none are saddled with legacy regulations designed for different services in a different era.
