This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC's ("Frontline's") counsel concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On June 25, 2007, Jonathan Blake and Gerard Waldron met with Bruce Gottlieb, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael J. Copps, and Conner Raso, an intern in Commissioner Copps' office. In the meeting, the parties discussed Frontline's Public Safety Deployment Plan and the many benefits the public/private partnership proposed by Frontline would provide the public safety community. Further, the parties spoke about Frontline's commercial provisions designed to promote innovation, competition, roaming and rural services. They also discussed whether the Commission's small business credit policies should be withheld from the E Block auction. Finally, the parties discussed the success of the wholesale business model in the telecommunications sector, citing the fact that the wholesale business of both Cingular and Sprint has grown substantially faster than their retail business in recent years. This success of the wholesale business in wireless mirrors the success that Level 3, and Sprint before them, have experienced in the wireline industry.
