**Request for Leave to File Late-filed Comments in Response to Seventh Further  
Notice of Proposed Rulemaking**

Fox Television Stations, Inc. (“Fox”), licensee of television station WDCA (“WDCA”), Washington, DC, Facility ID Number 51567, respectfully requests acceptance of late-filed comments regarding the entry for WDCA-DT’s post-transition DTV operations in Appendix B, the Commission’s proposed DTV Table of Allotments.


WDCA-DT’s Construction Permit, File No.BMPCDT-20060519ACK, specifies its operation at 500 kW effective radiated power (“ERP”),227 meters height above average terrain (“HAAT”),from a tower located at 38 degrees, 57 minutes, 22 seconds North Latitude, 77 degrees, 04 minutes, 59 seconds West Longitude, Antenna Structure Registration Number 1042983. WDCA-DT has applied for a license to cover that Construction Permit, File No. BLCDDT-20070411AAH. This site is located at WDCA’s main studio and also houses its analog antenna, as well as the analog and digital antennas of WDCA’s duopoly partner, WTTG, which also is licensed to Fox.

Appendix B lists WDCA-DT at a site located at 38 degrees, 57 minutes, 01 seconds North Latitude, 77 degrees, 04 minutes, 47 seconds West Longitude, at 500 kW ERP, 254 meters HAAT. As WDCA-DT is currently located, authorized and operating

from the antenna tower located at its main studio, at its authorized power, no party would be harmed if the Commission allowed this operation to continue. It would be needlessly burdensome for WDCA-DT to relocate to the antenna tower specified in Appendix B; moreover, it is unlikely that space on that tower would be available for WDCA-DT's facility any longer.

In light of the foregoing, Fox hereby respectfully requests that the Commission modify Appendix B to reflect WDCA-DT's actual, authorized facilities. The public will be served by the station's digital operation continuing to operate as it is currently authorized as of the transition, and, as the Commission already has found these facilities not to exceed its permissible interference criteria, no other party will be harmed.
