Quarterly Certification for January-March, 2007**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with 47 C.F.R §64.5001(c), AT&T Corp. (AT&T) hereby submits its quarterly certification for prepaid calling card services. This certification includes: (1) percentages of intrastate, interstate, and international calling card minutes for the reporting period; (2) percentages of total prepaid calling card service revenue (excluding revenue that is exempt under the military exemption adopted in the order) that are interstate and international and therefore subject to federal universal service assessments for the reporting period; (3) a statement that the AT&T is making the required Universal Service Fund contribution based on the reported information; and (4) a statement that AT&T did not purchase transport services from another carrier for its prepaid calling card services during the first quarter of 2007.

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**CERTIFICATION OF JAMES F. DIONNE
PURSUANT TO 47 C.F.R. § 64.5001(c)**

James F. Dionne declares as follows:

- A. My name is James F. Dionne. My title is Regulatory Controller. I am Chief Financial Officer for each of the various AT&T Communications interexchange carrier entities and am authorized to provide this certification on behalf of AT&T Corp. ("AT&T Communications"), as required by the above-referenced regulation. My current office address is One AT&T Way, Bedminster, New Jersey 07921. My financial regulatory organization is responsible for maintaining the books and records for each of the domestic AT&T Corp. regulated legal entities, and for preparing and filing required reports with, and making the appropriate regulatory payments to, the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), the Universal Service Administrative Company, and each of the state public utility regulatory commissions.
- B. In accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 64.5001(c), adopted by the FCC on June 1, 2006, AT&T Communications reports the following information with regard to prepaid calling card services provided by AT&T Communications during the calendar quarter ended March 31, 2007 :

- (1) Percentage of prepaid calling card minutes by jurisdiction¹:
- a. Intrastate: 32%
 - b. Interstate: 57%

¹ Less than 1% of the AT&T Communications 1Q07 prepaid calling card traffic is of unknown jurisdiction.

c. International: 10%

(2) Percentage of total prepaid calling card service revenue (excluding revenue from prepaid calling cards sold by, to, or pursuant to contract with the Department of Defense (DoD) or a DoD entity) attributable to interstate and international calls: 67.6%.

(3) AT&T Communications will be making the required contribution to the federal Universal Service Fund based on the information reported in (2) above;

(4) Section 64.5001(a) provides that prepaid calling card providers must report prepaid calling card percentage of interstate use (PIU) factors, and call volumes from which these factors were calculated, based on not less than a one-day representative sample, to those carriers from which they purchase transport services. AT&T Communications utilizes its own transport services to transport its prepaid card services calls to local service providers for call completion.

C. I certify under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
