

During these meetings, the undersigned made the following specific points.

- Informed the staff of the incorporation in the District of Columbia of the Public Safety Spectrum Trust Corporation (PSST), in a form similar to that described in the comments of APCO and National Public Safety Telecommunications Council (NPSTC), and that the PSST would seek to become the national public safety licensee contemplated in the NPRM.
- Urged that if the FCC adopts a “conditional auction” approach as supported by APCO and others, that the FCC must also adopt an expedited process for selecting a national public safety licensee.
- Reiterated opposition to band plan options 1 and 2, as set forth in the NPRM.
- Explained that APCO and NPSTC contemplate that the network sharing agreement between the national public safety licensee and the winner of a conditional auction would lead to a single, shared network with protections to guarantee public safety priority rights to the spectrum capacity represented by the FCC’s public safety spectrum allocation.
