
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to notify you that on July 3, 2007, on behalf of U.S. Electronics, Inc. (“USE”), New York, New York, the undersigned met with Angela E. Giancarlo, Legal Advisor, Wireless and International Issues for Commissioner Robert M. McDowell to discuss the proposed XM-Sirius Merger. In the discussion, USE took no position for or against the Merger, but discussed whether and how best to present certain issues possibly affecting action on the Merger to the Commission, the response to which referred to the comment cycle in the docket and ex parte, permit, but disclose, contacts with other offices within the Commission, including the Media Bureau.
