SWORN DECLARATION OF LARRY BOULÉ

1. My name is Larry Boulé. I am the General Manager of Delta Cable Communications Ltd., and have responsibility for the operations of Guinness Communications Inc. d/b/a Delta Cable Vision ("Delta Cable"), its U.S. subsidiary providing cable services in Point Roberts, Washington. I declare under penalty of perjury that the facts contained in this Declaration are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, and that I am authorized to give this Declaration on behalf of Delta Cable.

2. Pursuant to the Memorandum Opinion and Order issued by the Bureau in this proceeding on June 29, 2007, Delta Cable hereby accepts the conditional waiver from the integration ban for devices that do not include High Definition output or Digital Video Recorder capabilities. Accordingly, Delta Cable publicly commits to the following plan by this sworn declaration: it will (1) move to an all-digital network on or before February 17, 2009; (2) notify all of its analog customers of its plans to go all digital at least one year in advance of that event and again six months in advance of that event, and submit a sworn declaration to the Commission confirming that such notice has been provided; and (3) ensure that, at least one year prior to its migration to all digital, it has in its inventory or has placed orders for enough set-top boxes to ensure that each of its customers can continue to view its video programming on their television sets, and submit a sworn declaration to the Commission confirming that this is the case.
