Re: Consolidated Application of News Corporation and The DIRECTV Group, Inc., Transferors, and Liberty Media Corporation, Transferee, for Authority to Transfer Control, MB Docket No. 07-18

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 15, 2007, we received the Commission's Information and Document Request for Liberty ("Request"). This is to communicate our understanding, as counsel for Liberty Media Corporation ("Liberty Media"), of the clarifications of that Request in response to our questions and comments during a meeting with the Commission staff on June 19, 2007.

We understand that the Request has been clarified as follows:

1. With respect to Item No. I.B., the information requested in Subparts 1 and 2 should be provided for all responsive entities, including intermediate wholly-owned subsidiaries. The information responsive to Item Nos. 3 through 6 should be provided only for those entities meeting the following criteria:

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- a. It is in one of the Core Communications Industries,¹ or
- b. It is in an industry that sells more than a minimum of industry output to one of the Core Communications Industries; or
- c. It is in an industry that sells more than a minimum of the total purchases of the Core Communications Industry.

However, such additional information need not be provided for wholly-owned intermediate subsidiaries. In determining whether Liberty Media has an Attributable Interest in News Corporation (“News Corp.”) and its subsidiaries and affiliates, Liberty Media’s interest in News Corp. should be measured after consummation of the proposed transaction, which is the subject of the Consolidated Application (“Transaction”).

2. With respect to Item No. II, Liberty Media need not provide information and documents potentially responsive to this Request arising from its current ownership interest in News Corp. which will be exchanged in the Transaction. Liberty Media understands that DIRECTV and/or News Corp. will respond with respect to DIRECTV and News Corp. in response to Item No. 2 of the Information and Document Request to News Corporation.
3. With respect to Item Nos. III.A-C, Liberty Media need not provide information and documents potentially responsive to this Request arising from its current ownership interest in News Corp. which will be exchanged in the Transaction. Further, Liberty Media need not provide information and documents responsive to these Items arising from its ownership interests in Time Warner Inc. and Viacom Inc. which are not Attributable Interests.

¹ For purposes of the Request, “Core Communications Industry” is defined by the following NAICS (North American Industry Classification System) Codes:


- 512110 -- Motion Picture and Video Production (excluding production intended for theatrical release);
- 512120 -- Motion Picture and Video Distribution (excluding theatrical distribution);
- 515120 -- Television Broadcasting;
- 515210 -- Cable and Other Subscription Programming;
- 517110 -- Wired Telecommunications Carriers;
- 517210 -- Wireless Telecommunications Carriers (except satellite); and
- 517410 -- Satellite Telecommunications.

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4. With respect to Item No. III.B, the term "video programming company" means a company involved in the production and distribution of video programming in the United States, provided that the production of programming intended for theatrical release may be excluded as may entities that distribute programming solely via theaters.
5. With respect to foreign entities (*i.e.* entities located outside the United States, its territories and possessions), information need only be provided if such entities are involved in the production and/or distribution of video programming in the United States, provided that the production of programming intended for theatrical release may be excluded as may entities that distribute programming solely via theaters.
6. The Liberty Media directors, officers and employees whose files are to be searched for documents responsive to the Request are listed in the annexed Exhibit A.

Presently, we are searching for information and documents responsive to the Request. In the event that further questions arise during the course of our review, we will apprise the Commission staff.
