Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to inform the Commission that on July 6, 2007, the undersigned attended a meeting with Chief Harlin McEwen of the International Association of Chiefs of Police (via speaker phone), representatives of Access Spectrum, LLC, and Pegasus Communications Corp. ("Access/Pegasus"), and the following Commission staff to discuss band plan proposals in the above-referenced proceedings.

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During the meeting the Access/Pegasus representatives presented a band plan proposal identified as Band Plan 3.1, depicted on a chart that also included "Band Plan 3" as set forth in the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("FNPRM"). The undersigned and Chief McEwen indicated that APCO and the National Public Safety Telecommunications Council ("NPSTC") had supported Band Plans 3, 4, or 5, in response to the FNPRM, and their view that the newly proposed Band Plan 3.1, would also be acceptable, assuming that in either case the Commission adopted a plan to ensure reimbursement for public safety narrowband licensees that incur costs to reprogram radios to the new channel allotments.

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Access/Pegasus has separately filed an *ex parte* letter with the band plan chart used in the July 6 meeting.
