**SUPPLEMENT TO REQUEST FOR WAIVER
OF THE SET-TOP BOX INTEGRATION BAN**

Volcano Vision, Inc. ("Volcano Vision"), by its attorneys, and pursuant to conditions set forth *In the matter of Consolidated Requests for Waiver of Section 76.1204(a) of the Commission's Rules*, Memorandum Opinion And Order, DA 07-2921, at Para. 62, released June 29, 2007 ("*Consolidated Order*"), hereby submits a Declaration of its commitment to move to an all-digital network.


The attached Declaration, executed by Sharon Lundgren, President of Volcano Vision, confirms to the Commission that Volcano Vision commits to move to an all-digital network on or before February 17, 2009; it has notified all of its analog customers of its plans to go all digital at least one year in advance of that event and again six months in advance of that event; it ensures that, at least one year prior to its migration to all digital, it had in its inventory or had placed orders for

enough set-top boxes to ensure that each of its customers can continue to view its video programming on their television sets; and it publicly commits to this plan by sworn declaration.

Volcano Vision submits this Supplement in satisfaction of the findings and conclusions set forth by the Commission in the *Consolidated Order*.

DECLARATION


I, Sharon Lundgren, hereby state and declare:

1. I am President of Volcano Vision, Inc. a small cable television operator and recipient of a limited conditional waiver granted by the Commission in the matter of *Consolidated Requests for Waiver of Section 76.1204(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules, Memorandum Opinion and Order*, DA 07-2921, CS Docket 97-80, released June 29, 2007 ("*Order*").
2. Volcano Vision, Inc. has begun converting its cable television system to an all-digital network and will complete the transition on or before February 17, 2009. Completion is scheduled to be completed by early 2008, and certainly no later than February 17, 2009.
3. Volcano Vision, Inc. has provided notification to all of its analog customers of its plans to go all digital at least one year in advance of that event and again at least six months in advance of that event.
4. At least one year prior to its migration to all digital, Volcano Vision, Inc. had in its inventory or had placed orders for enough set-top boxes to ensure that each of its customers can continue to view Volcano Vision, Inc.'s video programming on their television sets. Those boxes consist of Motorola digital set-top box models DCT-700, DCT-2000 and DCT-2500, all of which are low-end boxes and none of which offer High Definition or Digital Video Recording capabilities, in accordance with the terms of the *Order*.
5. Volcano Vision, Inc. publicly commits to the plan to convert its cable television system to an all-digital network, as presented to its customers and as set forth in the record herein.

6. I verify that these facts are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief, except that I do not and need not attest to those facts which are subject to official notice by the Commission.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
