On July 9, 2007, Kathleen Grillo and Karen Zacharia of Verizon and Scott Angstreich of Kellogg, Huber, Hansen, Todd, Evans & Figel, P.L.L.C., met with Sam Feder, General Counsel, and Matthew Berry, Diane Griffin Holland, Christopher Killion, and Ajit Pai from the Office of the General Counsel to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. Verizon stated that the Commission should move forward and ensure that all VoIP services are considered interstate services — regardless of the technology or provider — and are subject to the same rules and regulations. In particular, the Commission should ensure that all VoIP providers, regardless of platform, compete on a level playing field, and that none are saddled with legacy regulations designed for different services in a different era.
