This is to inform you that, on July 10, 2007, Gigi Sohn, President, Public Knowledge, Christopher Libertelli, Senior Director, Government and Regulatory Affairs of Skype Communications, S.A.R.L. ("Skype"), Rick Whitt, Washington Telecom and Media Counsel, Google, Inc., Markham Erickson, Executive Director of the Open Internet Coalition, and the undersigned met with Bruce Gottlieb, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps, and with Ian Dillner, Legal Advisor to the Chairman. The purpose of the meetings was to discuss issues relating to the above-referenced 700 MHz auction proceeding, wherein the matters discussed are reflected in the filings made by Skype and the Coalition for 4G in America (of which Skype is a member) in that proceeding.
