Dear Ms. Dortch:

Access Spectrum, LLC; Dominion 700, Inc.; Pegasus Communications Corporation; and Radiofone Nationwide PCS, LLC hereby describe the details of their spectrum re-packing agreement, discussed in their July 6, 2007 written *ex parte* letter in the above-captioned dockets.¹ Access Spectrum; Dominion 700; Harbor Guardband, LLC;² and Pegasus Communications previously agreed to a slightly different spectrum re-packing arrangement, the details of which were set forth in Appendix A to their reply comments filed in the above-referenced dockets on June 4, 2007.³ The attached chart entitled “700 MHz Spectrum Exchange, v.2” and the accompanying map are revised versions of, and are intended to replace, the chart and map included in Appendix A of the reply comments. They reflect Radiofone’s agreement to surrender to the Commission its Upper 700 MHz B Block license in the Gulf of Mexico and illustrate the specific A Block geographies each licensee would occupy after the spectrum exchange is completed.
