Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 19, 2007, a notice of an *ex parte* meeting was submitted to the FCC on behalf of Access Spectrum, LLC and Pegasus Communications Corporation in the above-captioned dockets. However, the letter was erroneously dated June 19, 2007. Moreover, the letter erroneously indicated that the *ex parte* meeting had taken place on June 18, 2007 rather than on July 18, 2007. Please find below a corrected account of that *ex parte* meeting.

On July 18, 2007, Andrew Rein, Ruth Milkman, and the undersigned, on behalf of Access Spectrum, LLC, and Cheryl Crate, on behalf of Pegasus Communications Corporation, met with Richard Arsenault, Linda Chang, David Horowitz, David Hu, Elizabeth Lyle, Cathleen Massey, and Paul Moon. Mark Pagon, on behalf of Pegasus Communications Corporation, participated in the meeting by telephone. Access Spectrum and Pegasus discussed the timing and sequence of events necessary to accomplish the Upper 700 MHz spectrum re-packing proposed in their written submissions in the above-referenced proceedings. Access Spectrum stated that the relocation of its existing customers' operations would require additional equipment authorizations. In addition, customer systems would have to be re-tuned to the new frequencies. One approach to effectuate the migration would be to modify Access Spectrum's licenses but grandfather its customers' existing operations on the current frequencies for the period of time necessary to obtain the necessary equipment authorizations and accomplish the equipment re-tuning.
