Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 25, 2007, pursuant to sections 1.1203(a)(1) and 1.1204(a)(10) of the Commission's rules, Gunnar Halley of Lawler, Metzger, Milkman & Keeney, LLC, on behalf of Access Spectrum, LLC ("Access Spectrum"), spoke by telephone with Richard Arsenault of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. On July 26, 2007, again pursuant to sections 1.1203(a)(1) and 1.1204(a)(10) of the Commission's rules, Gunnar Halley, on behalf of Access Spectrum, and Michele Farquhar of Hogan & Hartson, on behalf of Arcadian Networks, Inc. ("Arcadian"), spoke by telephone with Mr. Arsenault. This *ex parte* communication is being filed pursuant to sections 1.1203(a)(1) and 1.1204(a)(10) of the Commission's rules in response to a request made by Mr. Arsenault during those conversations.

1. Arcadian has previously filed comments supporting the re-banding proposal of the Upper 700 MHz Licensees, and now states that it supports the spectrum exchange submitted by Access Spectrum, LLC, Pegasus Communications Corporation, Dominion 700, LLC, and Radiofone Nationwide PCS, LLC on July 26, 2007, subject to the conditions identified in that letter, specifically the adoption of Band Plan 3.1 or a variant as described in the letter.
2. Arcadian and Access Spectrum represent that the limited right of first refusal on Access 700, LLC's 700 MHz spectrum, described in Access Spectrum's *ex parte* submission filed in the above-captioned dockets on July 3, 2007, is not applicable to, and will not be asserted against the FCC with respect to, (1) any Upper 700 MHz A Block license conveyed to Pegasus Guard Band or to Access 700 Holdings, LLC as part of the 700 MHz spectrum exchange that is a component of the Upper 700 MHz re-banding; or (2) any B Block licenses surrendered to the FCC for cancellation as part of the Upper 700 MHz re-banding.
3. For each of the 6 MEAs in which Access Spectrum has customers with active operations on its Upper 700 MHz A Block licenses (MEA020, MEA026, MEA032, MEA037, MEA044 and MEA052), referred to in Access Spectrum's July 24, 2007 *ex parte* submission, Access Spectrum requests a 180-day Special Temporary Authorization



(“STA”) pursuant to section 1.931 of the Commission’s rules, effective upon publication in the Federal Register of the 700 MHz Order in the above-captioned dockets. Access Spectrum seeks these STAs in order to accomplish the spectral relocation of its existing customers in the above-referenced MEAs to the re-packed Upper 700 MHz A Block spectrum. Access Spectrum anticipates that, upon expiration of the 180-day STAs, additional time for customer migration in some MEAs may be needed, consistent with the timeframes outlined in its July 24, 2007 *ex parte* submission. If additional time is required, Access Spectrum will ask the FCC to issue any additional STAs needed to enable the completion of the spectrum relocation process. This request is intended to modify the request made in the *ex parte* submission filed by Access Spectrum in the above-captioned dockets on July 24, 2007.
