On July 28, 2007, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”), received a telephone call from Angela Giancarlo, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Robert McDowell, during which Ms. Giancarlo asked for CTIA’s views on certain buildout requirements in the above-referenced proceedings. Mr. Guttman-McCabe reiterated his belief that geography-based buildout obligations make little sense in today’s vibrantly competitive market. Mr. Guttman-McCabe further explained that the Commission may guard against any concerns that some carriers may “warehouse” spectrum through population-based buildout requirements, as CTIA previously had proposed in the record.
