Mrs. Secretary:

I am a representative of a small law here in the Chicago area. While the firm is far from poor, it would be nice to be able to manage our costs a little better. In this respect, I would like to draw your attention to docket number 07-16.

A colleague of mine recently brought this issue to my attention. MZZ Networks plans to offer fast, free wireless internet to 95% of the United States on a 10 year build out plan. I can foresee a society where everyone has access to the internet and is able to make use of the unlimited resources at no cost to the individual or the government. From my point of view, I could take more pro bono cases if I wasn't facing the cost of expensive internet access.

I frequently send and receive voluminous case files and although dial-up is cheaper, that isn't a practical option. Not to mention, the connection is second-rate at best.

For these reasons, I ask that you rule in favor of docket number 07-16.
