Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 2, 2007, I, as counsel for Level 3 Communications, LLC (“Level 3”), left a voicemail message with Anthony Dale, the Commission’s Managing Director, concerning the above-referenced proceedings. Specifically, I clarified that Level 3 and other undersea cable operators—including Apollo Submarine Cable System Ltd., Hibernia Atlantic, Pacific Crossing Limited, and VSNL Telecommunications (US) Inc. (“VSNL”) (collectively, “Submarine Cable Operators”)—continue to support the most expedient action on VSNL’s petition for rulemaking in RM-11312 (“VSNL Petition”), including the option of adopting a further notice of proposed rulemaking as part of the item containing the Commission’s forthcoming report and order in MD Docket No. 07-81. The Submarine Cable Operators believe that at this time, such a further notice of proposed rulemaking is preferable to a stand-alone notice of proposed rulemaking, the initiation of which could delay further action on the VSNL Petition.
