Today, Derrick Owens, on behalf of the Western Telecommunications Alliance (WTA), John Rose, Stuart Polikoff, and Claire Eisenberg on behalf of the Organization for the Promotion and Advancement of Small Telecommunications Companies (OPASTCO), and Joshua Seidemann, on behalf of the Independent Telephone and Telecommunications Alliance (ITTA), met with John Hunter of Commissioner McDowell's office and Chris Moore of Commissioner Tate's office to discuss the above-captioned proceeding.

The associations reiterated their support for the Joint Board's recommendation to impose a temporary cap on support for competitive eligible telecommunications carriers (CETCs), which have been demonstrated to be the cause of recent rapid growth in the Universal Service Fund. The associations support the cap as a reasonable interim measure while long-term solutions are developed.
