Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 8, 2007, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, and David Redl, Counsel, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association®, met with Chris Moore, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate, and Wayne Leighton, Acting Advisor to the Commissioner, to discuss various wireless industry regulatory priorities, including a national regulatory framework, various spectrum issues, universal service and interconnection.

Specifically, CTIA expressed its support for Commission action on a national framework for wireless, including Commission recognition that early termination fees are part of wireless carriers' rates subject to exclusive federal jurisdiction. CTIA also discussed implementation issues involving spectrum clearing in the AWS bands, and the importance of the 700 MHz spectrum being auctioned on schedule. Finally, CTIA outlined its support for comprehensive reforms to the universal service systems, particularly CTIA's proposals to reform the high-cost universal service mechanisms and intercarrier compensation regimes.
