Dear FCC Commissioners,

Thank you for this public comment period to share our views about the effects of communication tower lighting on migratory birds. We ask that all new or renovated towers, use medium intensity white strobe lights rather than the continuous red lights or the slow pulsating lights. Only the medium intensity strobe white lights can reduce the bird collision numbers significantly.

As to existing towers, we ask that as the current red obstructive lights burn out, they be replaced with the medium intensity white strobe lighting. We believe these measures are in concert with FAA guidelines as well.

A written reply regarding your final decision would be appreciated. Thank you again .
