Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. ("Pac-West") and pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this is to provide notice of an *ex parte* meeting held yesterday in connection with the above-referenced proceedings. The meeting was attended by Tamar E. Finn, Joshua M. Bobeck, and the undersigned counsel of Bingham McCutchen, and, by telephone, Stephen Dubé of CXO, L.L.C. and Ethan Sprague of Pac-West (together the "Pac-West Participants"). The Pac-West Participants met with Jeremy Miller, Deputy Division Chief of the Competition Policy Division of the Wireline Competition Bureau, and Rodney McDonald and John Adams of the Competition Policy Division, and Stanley Scheiner of the Office of General Counsel and, in a separate telephone conversation with the undersigned, Michelle Carey, Senior Legal Advisor to the Chairman (together the "FCC Participants"). The purpose of these meetings was to discuss the points raised in Pac-West's July 24, 2007, Application to discontinue service in its Eastern Region and its August 13, 2007 Reply to the Opposition filed in these proceedings by Dollar Phone Corp. on August 10, 2007.

In addition to discussing the points raised in these submissions, the Pac-West Participants advised the FCC Participants that since its Reply was filed, Pac-West has been advised by Verizon Business that 20,772 Dollar Phone local access numbers are scheduled to be ported to RNK on August 16, 2007. This represents over two-thirds of the 30,000 Pac-West DID numbers that Dollar Phone reported it needs to port to another carrier. (Opposition at 6 & 11.) A copy of the email from Ms. Johnson-Chapman at Verizon Business advising Pac-West of the port-out is attached to this letter (the names of other Pac-West customers have been redacted).

The Pac-West Participants also raised the possibility of extending the discontinuance date until August 31, 2007 in order to give Dollar Phone an additional 5 business days to complete the migration of its remaining numbers. The Pac-West Participants discussed the serious concerns raised by any longer extension of service in the Eastern


