
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to report a permitted, oral *ex parte* communication of Frontline Wireless, LLC (“Frontline”) concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

On August 16, 2007, Janice Obuchowski spoke with Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein. The parties discussed the obstacles facing new entrants based on the rules adopted in the 700 MHz *Report and Order* and the importance of eliminating such impediments. Ms. Obuchowski stressed that one of the most problematic obstacles in the Commission’s rules is that the DE credit does not apply to otherwise eligible small businesses who wish primarily to operate as wholesalers in the public interest.
