On behalf of Conterra Ultra Broadband LLC, I submit this notice of a telephonic *ex parte* communication held on August 24, 2007 between Angela Giancarlo and me. I also left messages with Bruce Liang Gottlieb, Erika Olsen, and Renee Crittendon. In each of these communications I explained: (1) the need for the Commission to act quickly to resolve WT 07-54; (2) that it is unfair that FiberTower, but no one else, has a waiver of the Commission's rules; (3) that no party has identified any interference caused by FiberTower's deployment of 2' microwave dishes; and (4) that Commission inaction is harming Conterra's ability to make rational investment decision.
