On August 27, 2007, on behalf of AT&T, Inc., Robert W. Quinn, Senior Vice President Federal Regulatory, Brian Fontes, Vice President Federal Relations and James Bugel, Executive Director, Federal Regulatory, met with Derek Poarch, Chief, Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau, Carol Simpson, Associate Chief and Tim Peterson, Chief of Staff, to discuss E-911.

AT&T addressed the importance of E-911 and its commitment to the provisioning of E-911 services. AT&T expressed concern about the potential enforcement date regarding wireless E-911 accuracy at the PSAP level. AT&T recommends that carriers be permitted to file compliance plans with benchmarks as an effective means to ensure compliance with new FCC wireless E-911 rules.
