Re: WT Docket No. 07-16 and WT Docket No. 07-30 – Notification of Oral Ex Parte Presentation

On August 29, 2007, John Muleta, CEO of M2Z Networks, Inc., Michael R. Gardner, Esq., Gregory L. Rohde of E-Copernicus, Steve Perry of Dutko Worldwide and the undersigned met with Commissioner Robert M. McDowell and his legal Advisor, Angela Giancarlo. The discussion involved the status of M2Z's pending license application and forbearance petition and the detailed nature of M2Z's public interest showing before the Commission. The bulk of the discussion focused on the fact that the Commission had already violated the timing provisions embodied in Section 7 of the Communications Act. In light of that continuing violation, we requested that an ultimate order concerning M2Z be reasoned and carefully apply the law to the facts. While M2Z has consistently sought a prompt decision, we explained that M2Z would rather the Commission afford itself additional time as necessary to make an informed decision (as it routinely does under Section 10 of the Communications Act) rather than have the Agency rush out an ill-advised and potentially arbitrary and capricious pronouncement.
